Atlantic Canada Electronics Stewardship (ACES), Saskatchewan Waste Electronic Equipment Program (SWEEP) and Electronics Stewardship Association of British Columbia (ESABC) jointly commissioned a review of the Environmental Handling Fees (EHFs) for Phase I products. The objective of the study is to analyze and make recommendations for EHFs for "Phase I" regulated products as listed in the British Columbia, Saskatchewan and Nova Scotia regulations, as well as for other computer peripherals (including keyboards and mice). The intent is to harmonize the implementation of the revised EHFs and methods for their determination across jurisdictions.

The objective of this webinar is to provide program members an opportunity to hear more about the report that was released on March 27, 2009. Attendees will be able to submit questions to the research team directly.
